Minimum Qualifications for all Therapists:

Master's degree in social work, psychology, or related field. Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT), Licensed Psychologist (Ph.D./Psy.D.), Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor (LPCC), or a or Licensed Eligible clinician registered with the California Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS) as an Associate Marriage and Family Therapist (AMFT)/Associate Clinical Social Worker (ASW), or Associate Professional Clinical Counselor (APCC), either graduated from or currently enrolled in an accredited graduate program under clinical supervision, *or* registered with the Board of Psychology (BOP) as a Registered Psychologist or Psychological Assistant, requiring clinical supervision pre-licensure. Must be bilingual, English/Spanish.

Duties:

Provides assessment, crisis, individual, group, and family counseling as needed to high risk, low-income children, youth and their families. Completes a comprehensive psychosocial Assessment and Treatment Plan (ATP) and identifies strengths and goals for all referred clients. Maintains records reflecting case notes, including appointments attended, client participation, and progress towards goals. Documents all collateral contacts, works collaboratively with referring agencies and collaborative partners, and provides resource referrals for clients and their families. This position is supervised by the Clinical Supervisor, if unlicensed. If licensed, will report to Clinical Program Director.

This position will serve clients in South Orange County, in our San Clemente clinic, Family Resource Centers, and home or school sites.
